The disruption of the journalism eco-system: Can Social Media plug the gap? Is there credible evidence that a "Fifth Estate" as Dutton has called it (2009) is gaining traction to add something new and "networked" to the public discourse? Can social media be an effective replacement for a vigilant local media reporting on such a disaster? There is little systematic evidence that local voices were heard any more clearly to find remedies to the Grenfell tragedy. This form of platform journalism still lends itself to powerful existing institutional actors.
